Word order

In French the adjective comes usually after the noun

Un crayon bleu

a blue pencil

Un stylo orange

an orange pen

Remember all nouns in French have got a gender.

Une gomme = a rubber is a **feminine** noun in French so it has **une** in front of it.

Un sac= a bag is a **masculine** noun so it has **un** in front of it.
