Questions and answers

As-tu des frères ou des sœurs? Have you got any brothers and sisters?

J'ai une sœur. I have one sister.

J'ai deux frères. I have 2 brothers.

Je n'ai pas de frère ou de sœur. I don't have any brothers or sisters.

Remember

Add a silent "s" at the end of a plural noun.

One = un + masculine noun. Or une + feminine noun



Vocabulary

Ma famille = my family

Ma mère = my mother

Mon père = my dad

Mon frère = my brother

Ma sœur = my sister

Ma grand-mère = my grandmother

Mon grand-père = my grandfather

Mes parents = my parents

Mon oncle = my uncle

Ma tante = my aunt

Ma demi-sœur = my step/half sister

Mon demi-frère = my step/half brother.

Genders

Remember that nouns have all got a gender. They are either feminine or masculine.

To say my, you can use

Mon+ masculine noun

Ma+ feminine noun

Mes + plural noun (can be feminine or masculine)
