Vocabulary

Je m'appelle... **my name is...**

J'aians. **I am....years old.**

Quel age as-tu? **How old are you?**

J'ai un frère/ deux frères **I have a brother/2 brothers**

J'ai une soeur/ trois soeurs **I have a sister/3 sisters.**

Je suis britannique/ polonais(e)/ francais(e)/canadien(ne) **I am British/ Polish/French/Canadian**

Je suis grand(e) / petit(e) **I am tall/ I am small.**

J'ai les cheveux longs/courts. **I have long/short hair.**

Je suis intelligent(e) /bavard(e)/ sympa. **I am intelligent/chatty/kind**

Et **=and**

Grammar

J'ai ... I have

Tu as.... You have

Il a.... he has

Elle a... she has

Je suis... I am

Tu es... you are

Il est... he is

Elle est...she is

To make a negative sentence, add **ne ...pas**

Je **n'ai pas**= I don't have

Je **ne suis pas**= I am not

Il **n'est pas** = he is not

Elle **n'a pas**= she has not

To ask questions, use tu+verb and ?

Tu es britannique? **Are you British?**

Tu as un animal? **Have you got a pet?**

Add an S for a plural

Un frère

2 frères

Tip

Use " et toi?"

To ask a question.

J'ai un chien.
Et toi? I have a dog. What about you?

When I describe something or someone feminine, I need to add an "e" at the end of the adjective. Il est grand /Elle est grande **He is tall/she is tall**
