Building Blocks: PUPILS WILL KNOW :

[Building block from EYFS:

- Christians believe God made our wonderful world and so we should look after it.
- The Big Story of the Bible and The Big Frieze.
- God the Creator cares for the creation, including human beings.
- As human beings are part of God's good creation, they do best when they listen to God.
- The Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him, so he keeps his relationship with them and gives them guidelines on good ways to live (such as the Ten Commandments).

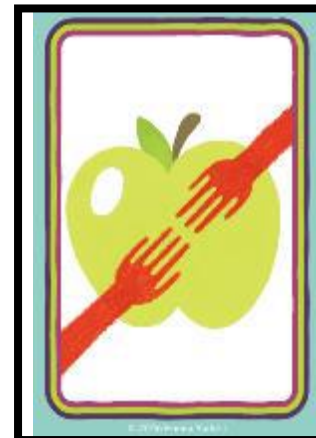
